**ICYMI:** Lynchburg starter Jayson Aquino took a no-hitter into the eighth and fell one out shy of a complete game shutout while leading the Hillcats to a 2-0 victory versus the Mudcats on Saturday night with 6,123 in attendance at Five County Stadium in Zebulon.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Last night's 2-0 shutout loss was Carolina's 13<sup>th</sup> of the season and their third shutout loss in a game started by **Yean Carlos Gil** in 2015. Carolina is now 11-13 in shutouts this season and have been shutout the second most times in the league this season. The loss also marked the deepest that a pitcher had taken a no-hitter against Carolina this season. The Mudcats, however, were no-hit on opening night by the Salem Red Sox in a rain shortened game (7.0 innings, started by Gil) earlier this season.

**ON TO THE NEXT ONE:** The Mudcats play their final home game of the 2015 season today at Five County Stadium against the Lynchburg Hillcats. The Hillcats have won three straight in the series and today the Mudcats will look to avoid a series sweep with **LHP Matt Bywater** on the mound for the finale start. Bywater enters at 2-1 over three games and with a 1.53 ERA with the Mudcats this season. He was signed by the Braves as a free agent earlier this month out of independent ball and made his Mudcats debut 8/14 in Frederick. Bywater last pitched on 8/25 at home versus Wilmington and picked up his second straight win after keeping the Blue Rocks to three runs and nine hits over 5.2 innings pitched.

**ELIMINATION NUMBER:** The Mudcats enter today's game 8.0 games back of the first place Winston-Salem Dash in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half standings and were eliminated from post-season contention last night. Both teams have eight games remaining this season, but the Dash will play two fewer 2<sup>nd</sup> half games having had two cancellations since the break.

**YEAR-END ALL-STARS:** The Carolina League recognized **Johan Camargo**, **Connor Lien** and **Jacob Schrader** as year-end All-Stars today. **Camargo** was recognized as the league's top shortstop, **Lien** was listed as one of four All-Star outfielders and **Schrader** earned designated hitter of the year honors. League managers, general managers and local media chose the honorary year-end All-Stars and Carolina League superlative awards.

**TOP THIRD:** **Keith Curcio**, **Connor Lien** and **Dustin Peterson** were a combined 8-for-14 (4r and 5 RBI) while batting first, second and third respectively in Tuesday's 7-4 win versus Wilmington. The season high for combined hits in a game for the top three Mudcats' batters is 10 and was set on 5/7 vs. Lynchburg (**Sean Godfrey** 3-for-5, 3r, **Eric Garcia** 4-for-4, 2r, 2rbi, **Peterson** 3-for-5, 1r, 1rbi). The Mudcats top third also had back-to-back nine hits in games on 6/9 and 6/10 (6/9: **Godfrey**, **Curcio**, **Peterson** 9-for-15, 6r and 6/10: **Godfrey**, **Curcio**, **Peterson** 9-for-15, 1r).

**#WINNING:** The Mudcats are currently 4<sup>th</sup> in most wins in the league at 66-65 overall this season. Those 66 wins are the club's most during its Carolina League era. They were 62-74 in 2014, 57-83 in 2013 and 63-77 in 2012.

**ALL THAT POWER:** **Jacob Schrader** is currently 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in isolated power (.204), 3<sup>rd</sup> in home runs (14), 3<sup>rd</sup> in slugging (.466) and 3<sup>rd</sup> in extra-base hits (45). Schrader is also currently tied for the most extra-base hits (32) in the league since 6/1... **Carlos Franco** is batting .265/.368/.420 with the 2<sup>nd</sup> most extra-base hits (30) in the CL since 6/1.

**WHERE THEY RANK:** **Connor Lien** is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league in batting average (.283), tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> in stolen bases (32) and leads the league in most strikeouts (123)... **Carlos Franco** is tied for the 2<sup>nd</sup> most games played in the league (126) and 5<sup>th</sup> in most base on balls (58)... **Seth Webster** is 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in earned run average (2.75), is 2<sup>nd</sup> in WHIP (1.07), 1<sup>st</sup> in lowest BB-IBB/9ip ratio (0.55) and 2<sup>nd</sup> in fewest baserunners (9.81)... **Blair Walters** is 4<sup>th</sup> in the league in ERA (2.93) and 3<sup>rd</sup> in average against (.244).

### FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH:

- 2015 Mudcats reliever **Matt Marksberry** made his MLB debut on 7/31 in PHI (1.2ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 0so, 2ir-2irs).
- The Mudcats are 32-30 and are batting .237 with an average of 3.69 runs/game and a 3.29 ERA in the Second Half.
- The Mudcats are 47-41 since snapping their 12 game losing streak on May 29 (.246 avg, 3.97 runs/game, 3.29 ERA).
- Carolina's nine (8) remaining games include three (3) vs. Frederick and five (5) vs. Lynchburg.
- The Mudcats last reached the playoffs in 2008 while a member of the Southern League (Double-A, Florida Marlins).
- **Seth Webster** leads all of Minor League Baseball in K/BB ratio (12.14) among qualified pitchers.
- **Connor Lien** leads the league in most outfield assists (19) and double plays (6).

### MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES

**BRICENO:** Was 2-for-4 on 6/28 and brought his avg. up to .200 or above (.203) for the first time since 4/15 (.200).

**CURCIO:** Hit .542/.656/.792 (6r, 3 2b, 1hr, 5rbi) between 6/8 and 6/14 and was named Player of the Week.

**CAMARGO:** First home run of the season was a 2-run shot to right on 8/16 in Frederick.

**FRANCO:** Led the Carolina League with 14 extra base hits in June (14 xbh, 8 2b, 2 3b, 4hr).

**GIARDINA:** Had back-to-back multi hit games on 5/30 (2-for-4, R) and 5/31 (2-for-4, RBI) versus Wilmington.

**HARPER:** Was 1-for-2 w/2 RBI on 7/2 vs. WS. Also made bare hand catch that was SportsCenter's Top 10 No. 1 play.

**KRIETEMEIER:** Hit safely in 5 straight games between 7/24-8/15 and had go-ahead 2-run 2B in 10<sup>th</sup> in Wilmington.

**LIEN:** Hit .375/.429/.667 from 7/6-7/12 (9-for-24, 3r, 2hr, 6rbi, 5sb, 1.095 OPS) and was named Player of the Week.

**MENESES:** Snapped a season high 12 game hitting streak after going 0-for-1 as a PH on 8/22 in Winston-Salem.

**ODOM:** Hit first professional grand slam on 6/9 vs. Potomac. The GS gave Carolina a 13-10 lead in the 8<sup>th</sup>.

**PETERSON:** Went 4-for-4 for the second time in a game this season on 8/24 vs. Wilmington at FCS.

**SCHRADER:** Leads the Mudcats and Braves farm system with 13 home runs this season.

**TL;DR:**

- Signed as a free agent on 8/13/15 by the Braves
- Began the 2015 season with the Southern Illinois Miners in the Frontier League and was 8-4 with a 2.36 ERA over 16 starts.
- Threw the first (nine inning) no-hitter in Southern Illinois Miners history on 6/12/15 (9ip, 0h, 0r, 2bb, 10so) vs. the Evansville Otters.
- Was named the Frontier League pitcher of the year following the 2014 season (8-4, 2.37 ERA, 21g, 20gs, 129.1ip, 86h, 46r, 34er, 60bb, 114so)
- Originally drafted by the Orioles in the 7th round of the 2010 draft out of Pepperdine.
- Spent the majority of the 2012 season with the Frederick Keys and was 1-2 with a 5.67 ERA over 19 games and five starts.
- Was 3-7 with a 3.63 ERA over 44 games and 19 starts in the Orioles system between 2011 and 2012.

**LAST START:** Bywater last started for the Mudcats on 8/25 against the Blue Rocks and led the Mudcats to a 7-4 home while earning his second straight victory. He held the Blue Rocks scoreless through the fourth before allowing two runs in the fifth. In all he allowed three earned runs and nine hits over five and 2/3 innings and finished with his second straight home win. Bywater finished the start with a walk, three strikeouts and 99 pitches (71 strikes) over his near six inning start.

**2015:** The Braves signed LHP Matt Bywater on 8/13/15 and assigned him to Carolina after RHP Andrew Thurman was promoted to Double-A Mississippi. 8/14: Allowed three unearned runs and suffered a tough luck loss in his Mudcats debut in Frederick. He walked five, struck out eight and allowed five hits over five innings pitched. All three runs scored in the third and followed a two-out fielding error by Carlos Franco. The Mudcats lost the game 3-2 after also scoring two runs in the third.

Bywater was most recently with the Southern Illinois Miners of the Independent Frontier League and was 8-4 with a 2.36 ERA over 16 starts before joining the Braves system. He entered the 2015 season with Southern Illinois as the reigning Frontier League pitcher of the year after posting a 2.36 ERA over 21 starts and 20 games with Southern Illinois in 2014. Bywater threw the first no-hitter in Southern Illinois Miners history on 6/12/15 against the Evansville Otters. Bywater walked a batter in the fifth, walked one in the ninth and struck out 10 in the no-hit performance.

Bywater was originally drafted by the Orioles in the 7th round of the 2010 draft out of Pepperdine. He made his debut with the GCL Orioles in 2011 and posted a 0.59 ERA over six games and four starts before moving to Delmarva later that same year. He finished his affiliated baseball career in Bowie in 2012 after making just one appearance in September of that season with the Baysox. He spent the majority of the 2012 season with the Frederick Keys and was 1-2 with a 5.67 ERA over 19 games and five starts.

The Thousand Oaks, CA native was 3-7 with a 3.63 ERA over 44 games and 19 starts in the Orioles system between 2011 and 2012.

# CAROLINA STARTING PITCHING NOTES

## MUDDY'S MENTIONABLES

**BARKER:** Made spot start for Triple-A Gwinnett on 7/5 vs. Charlotte (4.1ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 3bb, 7so). Left with two men on (both later scored) in the fifth.

**BROSIUS:** Placed on the disabled list on 5/14. Last pitched on 5/7 vs. Lynchburg (6.0ip, 4h, 0r, 0er, 1bb, 4so).

**BYWATER:** Struck out seven over seven scoreless frames while earning his first win on 8/20 vs. Salem at Five County Stadium.

**FURNEY:** Struck out a season high seven batters over seven innings on 5/22 in Wilmington (7.0ip, 8h, 3r, 2er, 2bb, 7so).

**GIL:** Tossed a seven inning one-hit shutout (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 6so) while earning his second straight victory since returning from Rome on 8/24 vs Wilmington.

**JANAS:** Placed on disabled list on 5/8. Led the league in ERA (0.56), WHIP (0.53) and lowest average against (.140) before going on DL.

**PARSONS:** Earned a victory in his first start with Carolina on 7/21 vs. Wilmington (5ip, 8h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 0so).

**POVSE:** Held the Red Sox to a run and four hits over six quality innings and earned first win on 7/9 in Salem.

**SIMS:** Struck out a season high eight batters over six full innings on 7/16 vs. Winston-Salem. Earned the win after allowing just one run on five hits.

**THURMAN:** Allowed a leadoff double, but then retired 21 straight over seven scoreless and one-hit innings on 8/2 in Wilmington (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 7so).

**WALTERS:** Pitched through the seventh for the first time on 7/1 and earned his third win of the season as a starter.

**WASZAK:** Took a no-hitter into the seventh on 7/2 vs. Winston-Salem at Five County Stadium (W, 6.2ip, 1h, 1r, 0er, 2bb, 6so).

**WEBSTER:** Led Carolina League in earned run average from 8/16 through 8/21 (2.52 ERA).

**WHALEN:** Was acquired by the Braves in a four player trade with the Mets on July 24. Acquired along with RHP John Gant for Kelly Johnson and Juan Uribe.

**NEAR PERFECTION: RHP Steve Janas** took a perfect game into the seventh inning of game one of a doubleheader against the Lynchburg Hillcats on 5/6. He lost the perfect game bid with one out in the final inning when Clint Frazier singled to right. Janas tied a Mudcats' record for most batters retired from the outset of a game with 19 straight on 5/6. Steve Cook also retired 19 straight from the start of a game on 9/2/91 in a one-hit complete shutout win versus the Nashville Sounds. Nic Ungs was the last pitcher to throw a no-hitter in a Mudcats uniform; he no-hit the West Tenn. Diamond Jaxx on 7/29/2005 in West Tennessee. There have been four no-hitters in Mudcats history.

**#4 - Luis Salazar, Manager**

Luis Salazar is entering his fifth season with the Atlanta Braves and his first as the manager of the Carolina Mudcats. The 2015 season marks Salazar's 13th year as a minor league manager. Salazar guided Atlanta's previous Class A Advanced club, the Lynchburg Hillcats, to the playoffs in three of the last four years. His 2012 Hillcats club finished 72-68 and won the Carolina League title versus Winston Salem. Salazar first joined the Braves organization in 2011 after spending three years as the hitting coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers Double A affiliate. He has over 15 years of coaching experience and in his career has compiled a 567-623 career record. Salazar has also managed the Vero Beach Dodgers (Class A, 2006), the Gulf Coast League Dodgers (Rookie, 2002-2005) and the Beloit Snappers (Class A, 1996-1997). Additionally, Salazar has been the hitting coach for Triple A Louisville (1998-1999) and Triple A Indianapolis (2000). Salazar played in 13 major league seasons and for four different teams. He played for the San Diego Padres (1980-1984, 1987, 1989), the Chicago White Sox (1985-1986), the Detroit Tigers (1988) and the Chicago Cubs (1989-1992). Carlos Mendez enters his first season as the hitting coach of the Carolina Mudcats, his second with the Braves Class A Advanced club and his ninth season overall in the Braves organization.
